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Prostate Biopsy Instructions

You MUST have a driver with you

STOP ALL ASPIRIN, ASPIRIN PRODUCTS, AND BLOOD THINNERS

(<u>Plavix/Clopidogrel, Coumadin/Warfarin, Lovenox/Enoxaparin, Xarelto/Rivaroxaban, Pradaxa/Dabigatran, and/or Eliquis/Apixaban</u>) **1 WEEK PRIOR TO BIOPSY**. You must get an OK from your PCP that is it ok to stop these medications.

The day BEFORE your biopsy:

- Start Antibiotic with 1st dose in **AM with food** and 2nd dose in **PM with food**
- At 10 PM, take the <u>first Fleets enema</u>

The day of the biopsy:

- 3 hours prior to your appointment, take the second Fleets enema
- Take an Antibiotic dose 1 hour prior to procedure with food
- You will be given a single intramuscular Antibiotic injection prior to the procedure

Post-biopsy Instructions

If you experience a <u>fever greater than 101 degrees</u> and/or are <u>unable to urinate</u> following the procedure \rightarrow Call the office at 703-680-2111.

The biopsy procedure should take about 30 minutes.

You may notice some blood in your urine, stool, or semen after the procedure – this is normal. You will notice more blood the more active you are. This may last 4-5 weeks.

Continue Antibiotic twice a day until you have finished the medication.

The results of your biopsy will be in our office 7-10 days following the procedure.
